


#### THE MISSION

#### A Note from Your Treasurer

#### 31 January 2025

First Presbyterian finished the first month of the New Year with a bank balance of \$39,390 compared to \$74,737 at the end of January 2024.

Our income for the month of January. 2025, \$35,182, while greater than the same month one year ago, \$12,013, this January's number includes \$25,000 drawn from TPF to ensure adequate funds to cover planned expenses.

Expenses for January 2025, \$19,921, were slightly higher than for the same month in 2024, \$15,979. Until the church property has been sold, this will be an ongoing situation, and we will continue to see our monthly expenses exceed our income and continue to draw from our investments as necessary to meet our obligations.

Below are the year-to-date numbers for the month of January 2025 compared to the same month one year previous.

With our having celebrated the first anniversary of our joint ministry with First United Methodist Church, it was appropriate that the Memorandum of Understanding be reviewed. With that review, all shared ministry employees are now fully on FUMC's staff, and our share of the operating expenses has been adjusted to adequately share in the cost of the Ministries of Youth and Children as well as an appropriate share of other overhead expenses including space occupied by the Coryell Cupboard.

The mail continues to be received at the Grand Avenue address for the foreseeable future but, as reported previously, **our mailing address is now P.O. Box 31, Ponca City, OK, 74602**.
